- If venturing into the Pentland Regional Park, please respect the hills, they are steep, rough in places and exposed, go prepared.
- Vehicle access to the finish is via the Murrayfield Ice Rink EH12 5XN. NOT through the main stadium gates.
- When entering the finish, any bags will need to be searched before access will be granted.
